The COVID-19 pandemic has impacted millions of people worldwide. As of mid-August, there were 139,000 cases in Louisiana alone; over 12,000 of which, were in children under age 18.

Because children who have recovered from the COVID-19 virus are more likely to have long-term physical, cognitive, and emotional effects that persistently linger after recovery, Children's Hospital New Orleans is proud to be the first in the area to offer a dedicated Post COVID-19 Clinic to help pediatric patients with recovery.

Our interdisciplinary team of experienced pediatric specialists works with children who have recovered from the virus but need additional support to regain skills or function that were lost because of the illness.

Our physical medicine and rehabilitation, psychology, physical therapy, and occupational therapy departments work with patients and their families to address:

- Muscle weakness
- Poor endurance
- · Post-traumatic stress disorder
- Cognitive difficulties

Potential patients must have had a confirmed positive diagnosis of COVID-19 at least 30 days prior and must be asymptomatic.
