The Rehabilitation Program at Children's Hospital New Orleans provided rehabilitation services to 75 patients last year. Services include Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Social Work/Case Management, Recreation Therapy, Music Therapy, Rehabilitation Medicine and 24-hour rehabilitation nursing.

Children's Hospital New Orleans Rehabilitation Program treats patients through 21 years of age. The patient must be medically stable and have exhibited a decline in functional status that requires comprehensive treatment along with training and education of the patient and caregiver and ability to tolerate three hours of therapy per day. The Rehabilitation program is part of the larger hospital, so all the support services and medical services are available to provide your child the safest and highest quality of care. We are the only CARF-accredited Inpatient Rehab Pediatric Specialty program in the Gulf South.

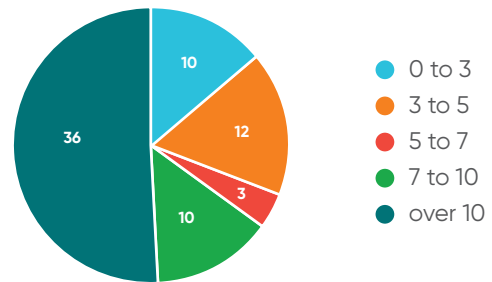

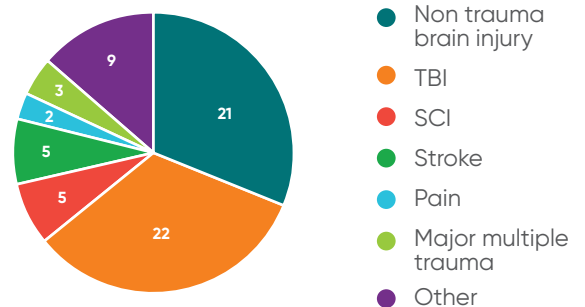
