

In-Kind Donation Guidelines

Children's Hospital greatly appreciates donations, but we ask that you please follow the guidelines below to ensure our patient and family safety and respect for their privacy.

Donations of new toys, craft supplies, games, electronics & gift cards and needed year-round to provide support and enhance the experience for all of our patients birth to 21.

To protect the health and privacy of our patients, donations must be delivered to the Child Life Department. Individual room visits are not permitted. Children's Hospital Child Life staff will distribute your items throughout the hospital to our patients and families as needed. All donated items must be accepted and approved prior to delivery by the Child Life Department. Please call to set up a time for delivery Monday- Friday, during the hours between 9:00 am – 4:00 pm.

Our Monthly Donation Day provides much needed items throughout the year. Donations can be delivered to the donation bins in the Lauricella Pavilion or in the main hospital lobby on the first Friday of every month between the hours of 9:00 am- 6:00 pm.

Each month we request various items that are needed all year long to serve our patients and families.

January Latex Free Band-aids
February Play Packs & small stickers
March Cards (uno, playing cards, etc..)

April Board Games (sorry, connect 4, trouble, etc..)

May Lego (small packs & Duplo sets)

June Teens (journals, colored pens, nail polish, headphones, gift cards, etc..)

July Stress Free (stress balls, light up toys, fidget items, etc..)

August Baby (rattles, crib toys, teething toys, etc..)

September Playdoh (small containers & sets)

October Bubbles & Pinwheels

November Crayola Items (crayons, markers, pencils, model magic,etc..)

December Coloring & Activity Books (all ages & designs)
